I Love My Boss





Each and every one of the brave men and women that serve to protect our freedom are heroes and should be honored. This past legislative session we passed House Bill 7015, Florida's GI Bill. This bill

was signed into law on March 31st by Governor Rick Scott and established Florida as the number one "Welcome Home" state for veterans, military personnel and their families.

Florida's GI Bill creates the Congressman

C.W. Bill Young Tuition Wavier program. This program waives out-of-state tuition fee for all honorably discharged veterans as well as increases funding for the Education Dollars for Duty program to help more members of the Florida National Guard earn degrees.

This bill also aims to help veterans find employment, creating the non-profit Florida Is For Veterans, Inc. which will help retired military personnel keep Florida as their home by promoting the hiring of veterans and equipping them with needed job skills.

This legislation will also help make it easier for elderly veterans to get into Florida's state-run military nursing homes. It was a great privilege to help our veterans by reducing barriers to receive faster care.

Our servicemen and servicewomen deserve the best whether they are a member of the Greatest Generation or have recently served. Thank you for the opportunity to

serve you in Tallahassee and for giving me the chance to support our veterans by voting for the Florida GI Bill.

Meet Gateway to Hope Ministries Inc.

This is the Story of how Gateway to Hope Ministries Inc. came to be. It started about 10 years ago when the the Rev. Michael F. Messina Jr. noticed a need in his local church and community. The need was that people were hungry and needed help. The Rev. decided to start praying regularly for a soup kitchen and food pantry. In March in 2010 our President/CEO Randy Doramus was on a mens retreat weekend in Lake Placid Florida when God called him to start a ministry in Ocala, Fl. called Gateway to Hope Ministries, Inc. Knowing that by accepting the call to start this ministry Randy

would have to move his family from Cape Coral, Fl., a place they had called home for over 22 years, and recognizing the need to walk by faith in starting this ministry Randy prayed for confirmations that he heard God correctly.

In May of 2010 Randy was visiting friends in Ocala and attended a church service at St Patrick's Episcopal Church where the Rev. Michael F. Messina Jr. was preaching. In the service the Rev. was talking about his vision for a food ministry and how he had been praying for it for ten years. He proceeded to state that the person who was supposed to start that ministry was in the service that day! (Confirmation #1)

In late May of 2010 Randy was at his computer working for the day when he received a message from his sister in law asking him "when did you move to Ocala?" knowing that he had not told anyone yet of what God had called him to he proceeded to ask her "how did you know I might be moving to Ocala?" she stated that on his Facebook page his city was listed as Ocala, Fl. (Confirmation #2 God is in the details!)

In August 2010 Gateway to Hope Ministries Inc. was formed. Ever since then we have been making great st rides and feeding people in need. In March 2011 we received a large generous donation of Seed money from Sanibel Community Church to help carry us through all our initial start up costs. (Confirmation # 3 God will provide for all your needs!).

Today Gateway to Hope Ministries, Inc. is successfully serving lunch to over 2800 people, and helping over 130 families with emergency groceries monthly. We will continue to grow and help feed more people with Gods help, which is your help!

We are one of three 501c3 **SOUP KITCHEN** ministries in Marion County feeding anyone who needs food on every Monday, Thursday, and Saturday at 11:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M. Our clients have a choice from our hot food line, cold food line and also our desert line.

We also have a choice food pantry where our clients can chose the canned food they want once every 30 days.

We have less waste than handing out bags of food.

We are located at St. Patrick's Episcopal Church, 3803 NE 7th St. Ocala, FL.

We will feed around 60,000 meals this year.

We will give away around 350,000 lbs of food also this year.

What do we need?

That is not my definition of poor. Been there done it, and what I endured in no way resembles this definition of poor. How many have been in my boat? Through my poverty, I worked, even if unpaid. In kind

Can I tell you what poor is? Would you even listen?

You asked me a question and I will attempt to answer it through my eyes. What does the word poor mean?

It means getting rained on instead of getting rained out. It means doing without for long period of time. When I say doing without I mean getting a job earning wages at 9 years old, walking to work with a hole in your shoe. It means wearing clothes with holes in them. It means wearing clothes that are so small that you got second hand. It means not having a TV or not having a coat on a cold day.

When a person that grew up in a poor neighborhood where in a three block radius three quarters of the boys in our neighborhood went to jail, one died, some of the girls were molested. I was taken from that neighborhood at age fourteen and moved to the east side of town where life drastically changed for the good. Oh there were demons, but not quite as bad.

I stopped answering the question at age 14 because this is not a story of my life but a story of real poverty. Poor is not just the fact that you are poor but neighbors on both sides and all up and down the street are poor. Some will do bad things to get food for their families or just for themselves. Some do bad things because they are just mean. What is

One of the five core areas of focus for the CEP is Business Creation. Many people will immediately identify our Power Plant Business Incubator as a key aspect of our Business Creation initiative. The Power Plant is certainly an important part of that effort but it is not the only part. In this column, I would like to provide information on not only the Power Plant but on some other aspects of the CEP's Business Creation efforts.

Power Plant Business Incubator

While just more than two years old, the Power Plant is the most high profile effort in the Business Creation Initiative. This business incubator is a partnership between the CEP (which operates, staffs and manages the facility), the City of Ocala (which owns the building and leases it to the CEP), and Marion County (which helped to fund the start-up of the facility and includes Business Creation as part of its funding to the CEP as does the City). To date, the facility has graduated eight businesses which are still operating in our community and employing more than 70 people. Currently, the Power Plant has 13 residents and two affiliates.

Last summer, the staff reviewed and re-

vamped both operating procedures at the facility, as well as acceptance and benchmarking processes. The Power Plant Advisory Committee is a group of business and civic leaders who provide guidance and recommendations to the CEP staff at the facility approved the new processes this fall. Every tenant in the facility now must present their business plan to a committee and explain how their company is innovative. This does not necessarily mean that it is pure technology company but one that is providing a service or product in a unique way. For most of our residents, this includes the use of technology.

One of the great misnomers about the Power Plant is that resident companies are there for free. That is certainly not the case! Every resident has a lease which is fairly market rate. In addition to covering their utilities and maintenance fees, residents are offered a number of opportunities to network and grow and entrepreneurs. In fact one of the biggest benefits to being in the Power Plant is the opportunity to network with other growing businesses.

Assistance and Financing

However, not every business needs or

wants to be in the Power Plant but the CEP wants to assist any entrepreneur. While Angela Busler, the Power Plant Director, works directly with managing residents and the facility, the Director of Business Creation, Ryan Lilly, is available to provide business counseling and consulting with any entrepreneur. If you are interested in starting a business, Ryan is available to provide free counseling to provide direction and assistance. A number of education programs are held throughout the year at the Power Plant and the CEP building to assist entrepreneurs in addition to the one-on-one assistance.

Finally, the CEP has just finalized making its first microloan. These loans, made through the Ocala Area Microloan Fund

managed by CEP, are typically \$10,000-\$12,000 loans to assist the creation or growth of new businesses. The loans can go up to \$50,000 and can be used for working capital, inventory or equipment. Additionally, every loan includes mandatory pre and post loan counseling to ensure that your project is a success.

Growing entrepreneurs is essential if we are to grow a diverse, dynamic local economy. The CEP is laying the groundwork for a strong effort through our Power Plant Business Incubator, Business Counseling, and Microloan Fund. MOM MAKES BOMB THREAT AND GOES TO JAIL

Christina Cochran, 30, of Summerfield, was arrested and booked into the Marion County Jail for making a bomb threat. This incident started when Belleview Middle School leaders called Cochran to talk about her child. A Marion County Sheriff's Office School Resource Officer could hear the call. When school leaders told Cochran her child needed help, because he had made threats. All of the witnesses said that's when Cochran started using profanity and made the threat to "blow up the school." Law enforcement made contact with Cochran at her home, where she admitted to making the statement.

AVIATION U.S. NATIONAL GRID TRAINING TAKES PLACE AT THE MARION COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

The main campus, of the Marion County Sheriff's Office, served as host location for the Aviation U.S. National Grid Training. In an effort to standardize maps in Florida for both emergency and other operations, the State Fire Marshal, as the coordinating agency for search and rescue under the State Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan, and the Division of Emergency Management initiated the option to adopt the US National Grid (USNG) as the standard in Florida. This project will ensure a uniform grid mapping system across cit-

ies and counties in Florida, and will match the system used by the National Guard, the US Coast Guard and the US military when they are deployed into our state. The event included thirteen (13) helicopters from first responder agencies and media outlets. Plus eighty-three (83) professionals, from seven (7) counties, joined the training. The Marion County Sheriff's Office, through Marion County Emergency Management, offered this free training. Part of the training included formation flight training for helicopters and a K9/Aviation training that involved K9 Solo "leaping from the helicopter" to chase down the bad guy.

DETECTIVES RETURN TO THE SCENE TO COLLECT EVIDENCE IN HUMAN REMAINS CASE

The Marion County Sheriff's Office Bureau of Special Investigations Detectives completed the collection of human remains and other evidence from the backyard of home at 3070 SW 89th Place, Ocala. Detectives are working with both the Medical Examiner and the University of Florida C.A. Pound Human Identification Laboratory. At this time, there is no affirmative identification of the remains. "This is a tedious process," said Judge Cochran, Marion County Sheriff's Office Public Information Officer. "It will take months before detectives have the best information concerning DNA." It's

early in the investigation, but detectives started working this case when a witness came forward to talk about a possible homicide. The witness told detectives the possible crime took place in the year 2000 and it may have occurred at the above address. The witness further offered the name of a possible victim: Jerry Christilaw. Also, the witness told detectives Christilaw may have died during a domestic dispute. Detectives have a person of interest. "Right now, we will need to wait for the DNA evidence to come in and pair that information with earlier statements from witnesses in order to move this case forward," Cochran said. HEATHMAN TO FACE 10 COUNTS OF ATTEMPTED MURDER ON LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS

Dustin Heathman, 35, will face numerous charges including ten (10) counts of attempted murder on law enforcement officers. This incident started around noon, Sunday,

June 01, 2014 when a family member notified law enforcement that Heathman was living inside a home at 17161 N.W. 162 Terrace, Williston (in Marion County). A family member told law enforcement there were warrants for Heathman's arrest, plus Heathman was violent and had numerous weapons inside the residence. Marion County Sheriff's Office units arrived and soon learned that a vehicle parked in the yard was stolen and a female was most likely inside the home with Heathman. The incident took a turn when the female came out of the home, but Heathman refused to do so. As SWAT approached the home in an armored vehicle, Heathman fired an automatic weapon, hitting the vehicle at least eight times - striking both the driver and passenger side - and firing at least four times at SWAT members not in the vehicle. Law enforcement exchanged gunfire. Heathman was injured by glass fragments. He was taken into custody after surrendering. Heathman's injuries are not life threatening. No injuries to law enforcement. The female has been identified as Jennifer Brown and she will face a charge for stealing a vehicle.
