Over the last year, you have probably heard and read a lot from the Chamber & Economic Partnership (CEP) on the topic of workforce and talent development or NEXT works as we call it. When the CEP Board adopted our new 5-year strategic plan, Moving

In fact, we believe the communities which figure out talent, will be the communities that win the next half century.

I hear every day from our businesses on the challenges of finding skilled workers. These are viable, living wage careers that

have been overlooked for too long. I think we are realizing that the emphasis on everyone attending University not only robbed our community of desperately needed skills but robbed students of the opportunity to truly pursue their passions. We are changing that thanks to these partnerships.

Over the last three years, the CEP and the business community have been partnering closely with the school system to reimagine and reinvigorate Career/Technical Education. Instead of the traditional model of schools trying to reach out to businesses, we have flipped that conversation to businesses engaging with the schools. Our goal is not to tell teachers how to teach but to provide them with the resources and opportunities to help make learning relevant for their students.

Today, we have more than doubled the number of students in Career/Technical programs. Our efforts were recently lauded as a national model of innovation. The new

Career Choice Academies are setting kids up for success by teaching in-demand skills and providing pathways for both work and continuing education. We are partnering with both the College of Central Florida and Marion Technical College to ensure we have a seamless pathway to post-secondary learning in all of these areas.

We are engaging with our schools and teachers daily. Dean Blinkhorn serves as our Director of Talent Development. As a former teacher and business owner, he brings credibility to our efforts. Recently, Dean was named an Education and Talent Fellow by the Association for Chamber of Commerce Executives, our national association. This fellowship is very competitive and we are thrilled and honored that Dean was one of 10 selected from around the nation to complete this program.

The mission of the CEP is to be the catalyst for a prosperous community and this focus on Talent Development is key to that prosperity. By partnering together, we can keep this community Moving Forward!

## Five Ways To Help Prevent Veteran Suicide

(NAPS)—It's a tragedy: Every day, 22 U.S. veterans

take their own lives—a needless loss of 8,000 service members a year.

### The Problem

Returning veterans may experience divorce, joblessness, homelessness and hopelessness.

**3. Tell veterans and their families about helpful programs.** Encourage caregivers, spouses and friends to seek help on behalf of a veteran.

One outstanding option that's transformed the lives of more than 550 veterans and their families is the SHARE Military Initiative at Shepherd Center in Atlanta, Ga. This innovative program provides up to 12 weeks of intensive rehabilitation, at no cost to the veteran, to treat mild to moderate brain injury and psychological concerns of those who served in the U.S. military since September 11, 2001. Treatment plans are personalized to each veteran's needs. The program is open to all post-9/11 veterans, including those with other than honorable discharges.

Because of intensive and comprehensive therapy, rehabilitation and life coaching, SHARE has become a model for centers nationwide. Experts in working with veterans provide medical consultation, physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech and cognitive therapy, recreation therapy, case management, neuropsychology, chaplaincy and counseling.

**4. Volunteer or donate** to organizations battling the epidemic of veteran suicide.

**5. Support fundraisers and events,** such as the Shepherd's Men Run. Annually, a team of committed volunteers runs seven days of half marathons in multiple states wearing 22-pound flak jackets—to increase awareness of treatment options and suicide

prevention for veterans. Shepherd's Men have raised millions for this heartfelt mission.

## Privacy Choices A Click Away

### More Privacy Choices Are Just A Click Away

(NAPS)—If you're like most people, changing the settings on your computer or smartphone can be a frustrating experience, full of technological jargon, confusing menus and complicated controls.

That's why the digital advertising industry decided to create a simple and intuitive way for people to get information and make choices about certain types of online ads they get. It's as easy as clicking a blue triangle.

In the corner of many online and mobile ads today, there's a little blue triangle, sometimes labeled "AdChoices" or "Your AdChoices." That triangle is known as the YourAdChoices icon, and it can be your gateway to trustworthy information and control over digital ads.

When you see the blue triangle, it means the ad might be using information collected from other websites about your interests to help personalize advertising for you. The icon gives you information about how that process works, along with choices to "opt out" if you don't want to see that type of advertising, which is known as "interest-based advertising." It makes predictions about the types of ads groups of people might want to see based on data about the websites or apps they enjoy, such as sports, movies, hobbies or travel.

To protect privacy, most advertising systems are designed to not connect that data to actual names or identities. Instead, those systems use a non-identifiable string of text—such as jsf284vn732ebu19dp—for

each computer or mobile device, which lets them deliver ads to that device.

Most people find that type of advertising more relevant and helpful than generic ads. If you're shopping for a new camera, it can show you ads for discounts or camera accessories you might need. If your team won the playoffs, it can make it easy to buy the team's new championship gear. If you love to travel, it can help you find bargains and little-known destinations.

Perhaps equally important, those ads help fund the free websites, services, and apps you use every day, including e-mail, news, videos, social media, photos, maps and search.

If you want to learn more about an ad or control your choices, clicking on the icon gives you information about the companies that brought you the ad and a way to turn off the collection and use of data for interest-based advertising from those companies in the future.

In addition, to learn more or control your preferences for hundreds of companies at once, you can go to [YourAdChoices.com](http://YourAdChoices.com), which serves as a control panel for companies engaged in interest-based advertising.

When you visit that site, you get access to a tool that performs a quick system check and shows you which companies are currently customizing ads for your browser. With a few clicks, you can opt out of receiving those types of ads from any of those companies or all of them at once.

The site also offers information and tools in the mobile world via the [YourAdChoices.com](http://YourAdChoices.com) mobile website and the "AppChoices" app, available for download from all major app stores.

Run by the Digital Advertising Alliance, a non-profit self-regulatory program created and supported by the advertising industry, the Your Ad Choices program—including Web Choices and AppChoices—gives millions of people the tools to control their online advertising experiences. The icon is now served more than a trillion times a month worldwide, making it easy to find and use on all of your devices.

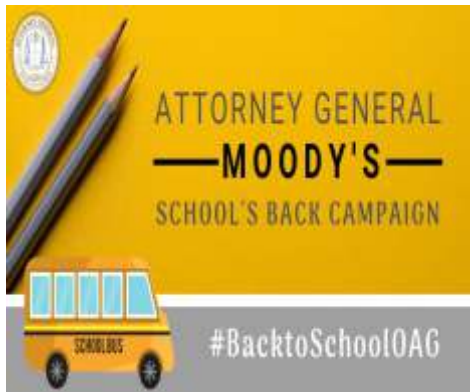

**Back to School**

TALLAHASSEE, Fla.—As millions of Florida children begin a new school year, Attorney General Ashley Moody is reaching out directly to students and parents with tips and resources. The weeklong #BackToSchoolOAG campaign will provide information about internet safety, the dangers of drug use, risks associated with vaping and more.

Attorney General Ashley Moody said, “This week, millions of children and teens in Florida will head back to school, and with a new academic year comes new risks and challenges that parents may not be thinking about. Online games and apps can create a venue for human traffickers to stalk children, drugs pose a major health threat, and the alarming increase in teen vaping cannot be ignored.

“Through #BackToSchoolOAG, I hope we can reach parents and students as the

academic year begins to encourage a continuous, open dialogue about some of the extremely important challenges facing Florida students today.”

Earlier this summer, Attorney General Moody launched a fact-gathering mission to learn more about the dramatic increase in teen vaping. The Florida Department of Health released a report in April, noting a 58 percent increase in the use of e-cigarettes among Florida high school students from 2017 to 2018. According to the report, nearly one in four Florida high school students now admits to vaping.

As Chair of the Statewide Council on Human Trafficking, Attorney General Moody is also working to raise awareness about human trafficking. Recent criminal cases handled by the Attorney General's Office involve teens lured online by human traffickers. Attorney General Moody is asking parents and guardians to talk to their children about cybersafety.

For more information about cybersafety, check out the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Booklet from the Stop.Think.Connect.

Drug use among minors continues Chatting with Kids about Being Online, to be a problem exacerbated by the opioid crisis. Using opioids just one time can lead to an overdose or even death. The problem is exacerbated by the increase of fentanyl use in Florida.

Attorney General Moody is asking parents and guardians to talk to their children about drug use.



**Statewide Council on Human Trafficking**

The Statewide Council on Human Trafficking was created to support human trafficking victims by enhancing available care options. The 15-member Council, chaired by Attorney General Moody, builds on existing state and local partnerships working to combat human trafficking.

Members include law enforcement officers, prosecutors, legislators, as well as experts in the fields of health, education and social services. The Council was created through legislation passed and signed into law in 2014.

**About Human Trafficking**

The International Labor Organization estimates that there are 20.9 million victims of trafficking around the world. Domestically, Florida continues to rank third in the nation in the number of calls to the National Human Trafficking Hotline.

Victims of human trafficking include children, women and men who are subjected to sexual exploitation or forced labor through force, fraud or coercion.

According to a study of U.S. Department of Justice human trafficking task force cases, 83 percent of sex trafficking victims

identified in the United States were U.S. citizens. The average age that a trafficked victim is first used for commercial sex is 12-14.

**Council Duties**

The Statewide Council on Human Trafficking was created to support human trafficking victims by enhancing care options available.

Council duties include:

- Develop recommendations for comprehensive programs and services including recommendations for certification of safe houses & safe foster homes.
- Make recommendations for apprehending and prosecuting traffickers and enhancing coordination of responses.
- Hold an annual statewide policy summit with an institution of higher learning.
- Work with the Department of Children and Families to create and maintain an inventory of human trafficking programs and services in our state.
- Develop overall policy recommendations.

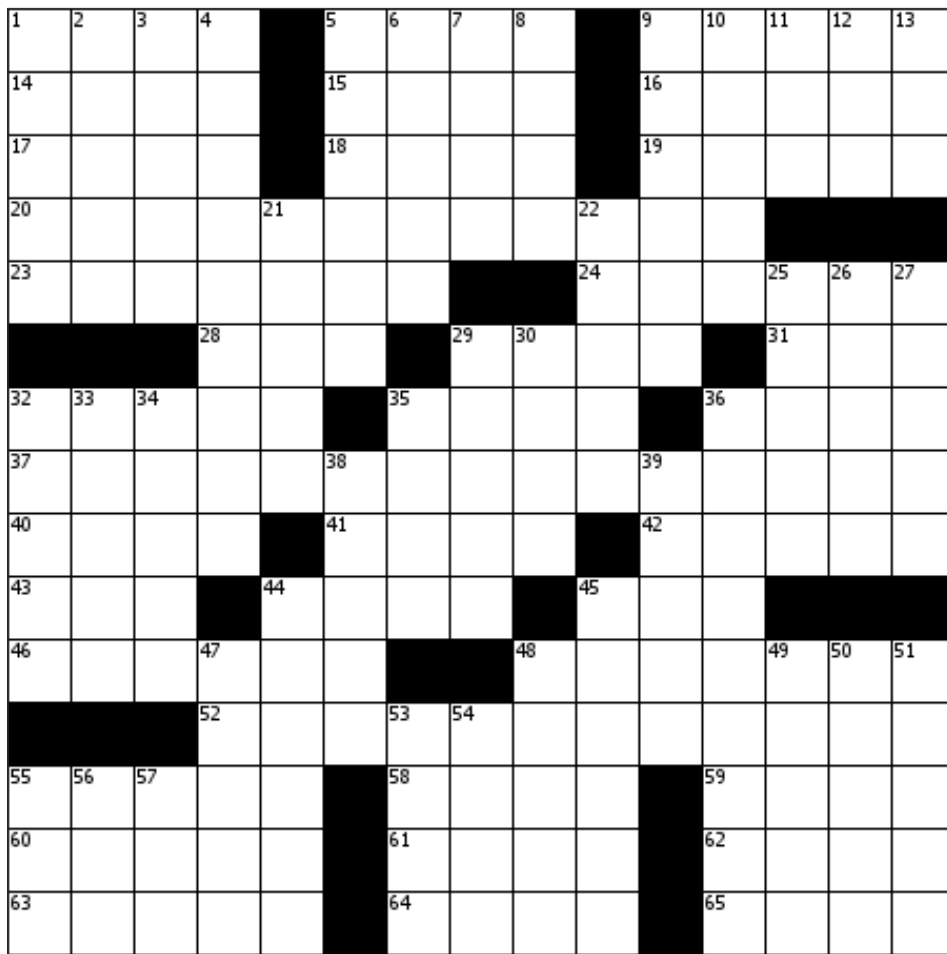

(NAPS)—When it comes to home entertainment, one of the latest innovations in TV viewing is really one of the oldest: the antenna—and budget-conscious consumers are thrilled.

**How It Works**

These days, with a new smart TV or inexpensive antenna, you can “cut the cord” and discover a vast array of shows and specials, new and nostalgic, via what's called a diginet or digital subchannel. In 2009, the government changed the way that local stations broadcast their signals, moving them from old-fashioned “analog”

signals to newer, more efficient “digital” signals.

That allowed every local broadcast channel to divide up its spectrum into multiple feeds—in the room that it used to take it to air just one channel, it can now air three or four additional digital channels (not just, say, Channel 4, but Channel 4.1, 4.2, 4.3 and so on), while still maintaining high picture quality.

With all this new space available, many new “digital subchannels” or “diginets” formed—and have partnered with local broadcast stations to air across the country in local markets. As a result, shows and movies from across the history of TV are now available regularly.

The fun and economy they provide is increasingly popular. In fact, the number of U.S. households that get their TV signals via over-the-air antenna is now more than 24

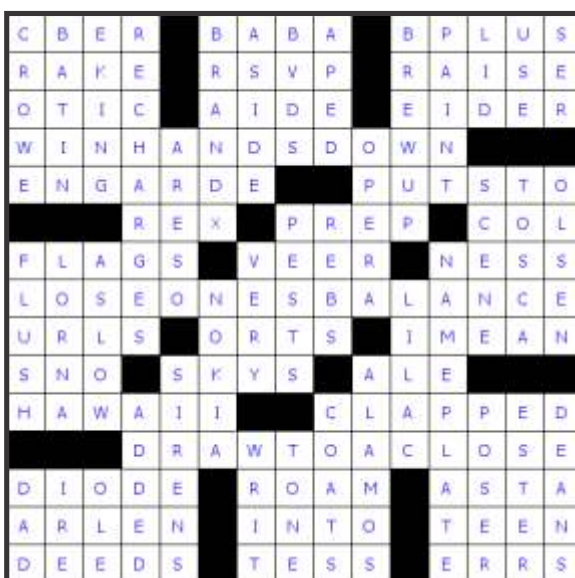
