Each month now for nearly 9 years I have provided this column predominantly about the CEP and the work we do. This month, I thought I would provide a little Q&A on the CEP for those who may not be familiar with us.

What exactly is the CEP?

We are the Ocala Metro Chamber & Economic Partnership or CEP for short. The CEP is the chamber and lead economic development organization for all of the Ocala Metro (Marion County). We do everything a traditional chamber does (but with a twist) along with leading efforts

around Business Attraction (bringing new primary employers to the area), Business Retention (assisting existing businesses), and Business Creation (entrepreneurship). We have a staff of nearly 25 professionals who are working every day to deliver on these activities and help ensure this is a prosperous community for all of our residents.

What kind of work does the CEP do for the city of Ocala and surrounding areas?

The CEP contracts with both the City of Ocala and with Marion County to provide certain economic development activities such as business recruitment. The investment by both governments is a fraction of what they used to spend on their own efforts but they receive a far greater return.

Plus we are able to match our private sector funding at a rate of \$4 for every \$1 of public investment.

Additionally, we have been able to partner with both governments on other projects especially during the last year with COVID. We managed the business assistance programs for the County distributing more than \$7 million in just over 4 months and have managed Microenterprise Loan programs for both governments.

What are some of your recent successes?

It has been a really good year! We welcomed new employers in the last year including the new Dollar Tree, Big Daddy Unlimited, and Amazon distribution centers and new manufacturing facilities like Artemis Plastics as well as number of expansions. These combined projects resulted in the announced created of more than 1,000 new jobs and \$100 million in capital investment.

We rolled out two really important new

programs: Impact and Sphere. Impact seeks to address the inequality of opportunity in our three majority minority communities through entrepreneurship. We have significantly expanded our entrepreneurship assistance in these communities in and assisted more than 400 entrepreneurs in just 6 months! We will be continuing to expand these efforts throughout the next few years.

Sphere is focused on expanding our community's footprint in healthcare by focusing on healthcare as an economic development target. We are working to attract more healthcare related support businesses to cluster around our ever-growing primary care hospitals and to assist with the attraction of more healthcare talent.

And I would be remiss if I did not mention that just over a year ago the CEP was named National Chamber of the Year by the Association of Chamber of Commerce Executives.

What are you looking forward to in the near (or perhaps distant) future?

We have so much growth happening in our community. We recently announced that we expect to see approximately 5 million sq ft of new industrial spec space to be built over the next 18 months. That is a massive amount of space and an incredible testament to the value investors see in this market. This new space will attract new employers and additional investment.

Big things are in the works for our Impact and Sphere initiatives and our efforts at growing Downtown Ocala are really starting to payoff with several major projects set to move forward in the coming months. We also hope to open the first of what we hope will be several satellite offices across the community later this year.

And I haven't said anything about the World Equestrian Center! It is, in a word, a game-changer. Work should begin soon on Phase II!

monoclonal antibody treatment sites. **Since opening these sites, the 7-day average of new adult hospital admissions has fallen 80%.**

"Florida has administered over 130,000 monoclonal antibody treatments, saving thousands of people from being admitted to the hospital. There is no doubt that many lives have been saved as a result of making these treatments widely available," said **Governor Ron DeSantis**. "Recently, the Biden administration decided to severely cut the amount of Regeneron monoclonal antibodies being sent to Florida and other disfavored states. That was concerning because there was a significant demand for the treatments and we wanted to make sure that if folks needed it, they were able to get it. I looked to see what other options were available for Florida. There was another very effective monoclonal antibody treatment called Sotrovimab made by GlaxoSmithKline that had recently received emergency use authorization. We went directly to GlaxoSmithKline, got Sotrovimab for Florida, and deployed it. It served as a bridge to get over the reductions, and fortunately, as a result of the success of early treatment, our infections are now so low that we have gone from thousands to hundreds of treatments per day. Florida is one of the only states in the country that

Dear Friends,
This comes to you from our desk in Tallahassee as committee meetings are in full swing. An informed person is an empowered person and so we hope to continue bringing

some reports to our folks back home. Most of the work being done, so far, is hearing reports from various state agencies regarding their operations and some forecasting about what next year will bring. On the financial side, Florida continues to rebound from a tough year 2020 where real GDP fell by 2.8% for the year. Thanks to strong conservative leadership from our Governor and Legislature, we have

recovered those losses with an average growth of 7.2% over the first two quarters of 2021. Personal income growth rates for Floridians are anticipated to be above 4.0% for the 2021 year, which is excellent news considering that the national average for 2020 was in the negative by about 25%.

Every ten years, coinciding with the U.S. Census, each state will draw a new district map for their elected representatives and Senators. This process, called Redistricting, must be completed by the Florida Legislature in the upcoming Session. This process will take up much of the focus and energy this year. We have many talented and knowledgeable staff working hard to help us accomplish this mission and we are very confident that the final product will be fair and legal. The Senate website has some excellent information on this topic and we

encourage everyone to utilize these resources and to be informed.

We have received many calls and e-mails from constituents around the state, on a variety of topics, and it is very encouraging to see so many people actively participating in their government. In a state with 22 million people, there are many different opinions and ideas, and it may feel like you are not being heard. Do not be discouraged, keep calling, keep e-mailing and making your voice heard. Better still, find a group of like-minded individuals and amplify that voice and you will find yourself better prepared to make a difference. "Nothing significant is ever done alone, but one person can make a big difference."

Thank you for letting me be your Senator, and for allowing me to fight for faith, family, freedom, opportunity and life.

currently has hospital admissions for COVID below pre-Delta levels and is also one of the five lowest states for daily infections."

"The State of Florida has continued to ensure monoclonal antibody treatments are widely available in Florida for all who need them," said **Dr. Joseph Ladapo**, Surgeon General of Florida. "Not only has it alleviated demand on the hospital system, but it has saved countless lives by administering more than 130,000 treatments since August 12. Responding to COVID-19 does not have one solution, but requires innovative strategies just like this, and the Department of Health continues to support these missions under the Governor's leadership."

Total COVID hospital census in our state has had 51 consecutive days of decline. The 7-day average in Florida for COVID-like illness emergency room visits is lower than 33 other states. To help reinforce Florida's supply of monoclonal antibody treatment, the [Governor secured thousands of doses of Sotrovimab](#) directly from GlaxoSmithKline last month.

The Governor was joined at today's event by Floridians who shared their stories about receiving monoclonal antibody treatment.

Doris and Wally Cortese have been married for more than 60 years and have seven children. Wally is a World War II and Korean War naval aviator veteran. Doris spoke about the couple's recovery, saying: "As the governor said, [monoclonal antibody treatment] saves lives. It saved my husband's life. You talk about a typical person who COVID should have taken. He just turned 96. He has a heart condition. He has COPD from smoking. He is diabetic. He woke up on a Tuesday morning and said, 'I need to go to the hospital.' We went and had him tested and I was tested. We both tested positive. He got the treatment and three days later he started feeling better. In six days, he was back to a hundred percent. I truly believe without our Governor and what he has done, my husband would not be here today in front of you to be a living proof of what this has done. I am just so thankful to the Governor for what he has done for our family and for all the other families."

Michelle Alberg recently received Regeneron prophylactically, and her mother-in-law and father-in-law successfully recovered thanks to Sotrovimab. Michelle stated: "I'm a healthcare professional, and unfortunately I was exposed to COVID-19 on the job. I knew that monoclonal antibody treatments can also be used prophylactically, so I looked up the location near me [and] was able to make an appointment for my treatment. I never became symptomatic and I had the peace of mind knowing that if I did, my case would probably be much less severe. A week later, both my mother- and father-in-law tested positive for COVID-19. I advised them to immediately go to the Bonita Springs location for monoclonal antibodies. They made an appointment and received the GSK [Sotrovimab] infusion the very next morning. In about 24 hours, their symptoms subsided. They are now less than two weeks out from their diagnosis and they're fully recovered. Thank you once again for putting the health of Floridians as a top priority, Mr. Governor, and for your fortitude to do what is right when so many in leadership positions have gotten it so wrong."

DeSantis to Biden

Governor Ron DeSantis to Biden Administration: Do Your Job, Enforce the Law, Stop Incentivizing Illegal

Immigration

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – Instead of changing course to stop the crisis of mass illegal immigration occurring at the southwest border, the Biden Administration has taken yet another action to further weaken immigration enforcement, which will exacerbate the Biden Border Crisis. In a [policy memo](#) issued this week by Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Secretary Alejandro Mayorkas, the Biden Administration directed immigration authorities to stop deploying worksite operations that enforce illegal immigrant employment laws, effectively greenlighting American employers to hire illegal aliens.

“This latest action by DHS should come as no surprise given that mass illegal immigration is this administration's policy, but yet again, Florida will fill the chasm left by the Biden Administration's refusal to enforce the law,” said **Governor Ron DeSantis**. “State and federal law explicitly prohibit the employment of illegal aliens. In Florida, we will enforce the law, and we will protect the jobs and wages of Florida's workers.”

This week's memo is just the latest directive from the Biden Administration to hamstring immigration authorities and facilitate mass illegal immigration at the southwest border. States bear the brunt of this administration's open borders agenda.

That is why Governor DeSantis has taken many actions to address the Biden Border Crisis.

Homemade Butterfingers

Ingredients

- 3 cups candy corn
- 1 1/2 cups creamy peanut butter
- 2 cups good quality chocolate

Instructions

Line a 9×9 inch baking dish with parchment paper (All sides too).

In a large glass bowl melt the candy corn in the microwave. Melt it in 30 second spurts and stir it well in between each time. When it is completely melted add the peanut butter and stir to combine. Pour it into the prepared pan, spreading it out, and smoothing the top. Let the mixture cool completely, about an hour.

When cool, remove the candy from the pan by pulling on the parchment paper. Place the parchment paper and candy on a cutting board. Using a sharp knife, cut the candy into bite-sized pieces.

Melt the chocolate and then dip each piece of candy completely into the chocolate. Remove and place on a piece of waxed paper until the chocolate is set, about 20 minutes.

Serve or store in an air-tight container.

“We want to thank Statlab Mobile, the Florida Horse Park and the Southeastern

Livestock Pavilion for partnering with us, and helping ensure Marion County residents had multiple opportunities for testing during the pandemic,” said Department of Health in Marion County Administrator Mark Lander.

“Such partnerships have been invaluable in our efforts to provide Marion County residents with rapid, responsive COVID-19 testing.”

At First Baptist Church of Ocala, 2801 SE Maricamp Road, CovidTestFL.Org offers free drive-through testing. Testing is available 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday and 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday.

CovidTestFL.Org, a COVID-19 mobile clinical testing service, offers a diagnostic PCR COVID-19 test that provides results within three days via a text message or email containing a link to results on a web portal. People who do not have access to email can obtain results by Expedited test results are available for an additional fee.

People who seek to be tested must enter the church parking lot entrance on SE 30th Ave. To be tested, individuals should bring a valid photo ID; minors under age 18 will only be tested if they are accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

People should be prepared to stay in their vehicles while awaiting testing. Only people who are being tested should be in the vehicle, with the exception of parents, guardians, or caregivers. No pets are permitted in the vehicle during tests.

Additionally, testing can be done at private labs, physicians' offices, pharmacies

and walk-in clinics throughout Marion County.

CONSUMER ALERT: Beware of Vaccine Status License Scam

TALLAHASSEE, Fla.—Attorney General Ashley Moody today issued a Consumer Alert

warning Floridians of a new COVID-19 vaccination text scam. There have been reports of fraudulent text messages being sent to Floridians asking for driver license details in order to remake licenses that show vaccination status. The text messages provide a link that sends targets to a spoofed Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles website with input boxes requesting Social Security and driver license information—including a place to upload a photocopy of a driver license.

Attorney General Ashley Moody said, “COVID-19 cases have decreased drastically across the state, but that hasn’t stopped scammers from finding new angles to exploit the pandemic. Please be on the lookout for phony messages and remember that the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles will never reach out via text and ask for personal information. Florida is not updating driver licenses to include proof of vaccination—any solicitation making this claim is a scam that should be reported immediately.”

Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles Executive Director Terry L. Rhodes said, “The best defense against scams like this is to know how FLHSMV interacts with our customers. We do not text Floridians

regarding the status of their driver license or request personal or medical information via text message. If you receive a text asking for this information, it is a scam. With only the information on your driver license, scammers can create many fraudulent financial accounts. All under your name, all without your knowledge. Do not respond to these texts and do not click on the links contained in the text message.”

Here is what the reported fraudulent text message looks like:



The link in the message will bring you to a spoofed Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles website.

Attorney General Moody is asking Floridians to follow the tips below to avoid these types of imposter scams:

- Know that the FLHSMV is not requiring driver license updates listing proof of vaccination;
- Do not automatically trust a number listed on a caller ID or in an unsolicited text message;
- Do not post photos of vaccination cards or driver licenses online, as they can be used to commit identity fraud; and

- Avoid clicking on links in a suspicious email or in a text message received from an unknown sender.

Report suspicious solicitations or COVID-19 vaccine-related advertisements to the Florida Attorney General's Office by calling 1(866) 9NO-SCAM, or visiting MyFloridaLegal.com.

Attorney General Moody Warns Floridians About Lethal Counterfeit Pills Flooding the Black Market

TALLAHASSEE, Fla.—Attorney General Ashley Moody is warning Floridians about the recent explosion in deadly counterfeit pills confiscated nationwide. The United States Drug Enforcement Administration recently seized 1.8 million fentanyl-laced pills in a two-month nationwide sting that launched on Aug. 3. Since the start of 2021, officials have seized more than 9.5 million counterfeit pills—an increase of nearly 430% since 2019. Fentanyl is a synthetic opioid 50 times more potent than heroin and is an accelerating force behind the increase in drug overdose deaths.

Attorney General Ashley Moody said, “We are seeing a nationwide increase in the amount of fentanyl coming across our border. We are also seeing a dramatic spike in the number of overdose deaths attributed to fentanyl. As Florida's Attorney General

and as a mother, I don't want anyone to abuse drugs, but please be especially warned that if you take a pill from anyone other than your doctor, you may be risking your life. Just one dose of fentanyl can kill, and with an increasing number of these counterfeit pills circulating throughout the country, the message is more important today than ever before.”

According to the DEA, opioids are responsible for nearly 75% of the more than 93,000 fatal drug overdoses in the U.S. in 2020. The flooding of new fentanyl-laced drugs could accelerate opioid deaths. According to the latest FDLE Medical Examiners Report, 21 people in Florida die from opioid-related overdoses every day. Last year, deaths attributed to fentanyl in Florida increased by more than 80%. Recent reports highlight the toll these deadly fentanyl pills are having on teens nationwide.

Just two milligrams of fentanyl can be lethal depending on a person's body size, tolerance and past usage. Following last month's sizeable seizure, DEA's lab results revealed that four out of every 10 fake pills contained a potentially lethal dose of fentanyl. According to the DEA, just a few years ago, about 10% of drugs tested contained fentanyl—that is now up to 40%. According to reports, the fake pills are being manufactured to look identical to prescription opioid medications like Xanax, Vicodin, Percocet and Oxycontin.


